AIMagn Gold Medal Award

AIMagn is proud to announce the launch of the AIMagn Gold Medal Award. This prestigious award will honour a scientist in the Italian community for extraordinary achievements in the area of magnetism and for significant activities in promoting Italian research in magnetism in the international community.

The prize's first edition will be awarded during the next ICM 2024 to be held in Bologna (30th June- 5th July).

Interested candidates should submit their applications at <u>segreteria@aimagn.org</u>. Any member can put forward the names of potential candidates. <u>The deadline to submit</u> <u>nominations is June 28th, 2024</u>. The awardee will be selected by an evaluating commission of experts in the field of magnetism.

The AIMAGN Gold Medal Award will be presented every two years. The next edition will be awarded during the MAGNET 2026 conference.
